60 years ago, thanks to John Chadwick and Michael Ventris, the Linear B writing system was recognised as used by the Greek citizens of Peloponnesian peninsula in the second millenium BC. Scholars have to look for satisfying answers for very difficult questions. Difficult - because the evidence of the inscriptions is relatively low.
